PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To address the needs in the field of youth work and education, aiming for a more professional, high-quality, and recognized youth work sector in Europe.
- To tackle the lack of policies and structures supporting and regulating the youth work sector in many European countries. This involves developing a curriculum and training program for youth NGOs to enhance the quality and professionalism of youth work, covering topics such as non-formal education, project management, financial management, and volunteer management.
- To improve the employability and career prospects of young people by developing practical tools and methodologies relevant to the current job market. This includes disaster management, networking, and organizational management.
- To foster greater collaboration and knowledge-sharing among different organizations working with young people across Europe. By bringing together diverse partners with varied expertise and perspectives on youth work, the project aims to create a more coherent and effective approach to youth work continent-wide.

PROJECT OUTCOMES

WP2: Comparative Research on Youth Work Studies in Europe

- Conducts desk research and stakeholder discussions to identify gaps in policies and propose improvements in youth work at national and European levels.
- Provides recommendations to enhance youth work, laying the foundation for the project.

WP3: Curricula for Studies of Youth NGO's

- Develops a customized curriculum covering non-formal education, management, disaster response, networking, and volunteer management for youth NGOs.
- Pilots the curriculum across Europe to meet specific NGO needs effectively.

WP4: Development of Youth NGO Trainings

- Designs and tests a user-friendly training program to empower youth NGOs in service, management, and leadership.
- Enhances NGO capacity through comprehensive training based on developed materials covering various relevant topics.

WP5: Design of a Distance Learning Platform

- Creates an e-learning platform integrating outputs from WP2, WP3, and WP4's training program.
- Empowers youth workers in NGO management through interactive courses and resources.
- Serves for project dissemination and partnership information, facilitating wider access to project outcomes.
